## 1. Classes

Classes last one hour and take place in Walthamstow or Tooting (see: <a href="http://www.banjosmith.co.uk/">http://www.banjosmith.co.uk/</a>). Please bring your own instrument.

Please bring a pencil and a folder to keep your music in.

Note that you must be over 18 to enrol for classes.

Class sizes will be around 10-15 students depending on venue.

# 2. Payment and attendance

All courses are filled on a first come, first served basis, so please ensure booking your place as soon as possible. Your place is secured as soon as your payment is received.
